Golden Boy Promotions

Roy Englebrecht

CAO of Golden Boy Promotions



Roy Englebrecht currently serves as Chief Operating Officer of Golden Boy Promotions the third largest boxing promotions company in America. He is the former owner of Roy Englebrecht Promotions, which was purchased by World Boxing Champion, Oscar De La Hoya in December of 2001, and folded into De La Hoya's new boxing promotions company, Golden Boy Promotions. Currently owned by De La Hoya and Englebrecht, Golden Boy Promotions is the promoter of the highly successful Battle in the Ballroom professional boxing shows at the Irvine Marriott Hotel. This bi-monthly professional boxing show is in its 19th consecutive year and is the longest running and most successful pro boxing show in the country.

Golden Boy Promotions is also the promoter of Fight Night At The Tank, record setting pro boxing shows at HP Pavilion in San Jose, Fight Night At The Garden in Bakersfield, and at the Rose Garden in Portland. They were also the promoter of the Los Alamitos Race Course and Del Mar Race Track Rumble at the Races and Boxing At The Beach pro boxing shows, first of its kind events featuring horse racing and professional boxing all on the same night, at the same location. Golden Boy Promotions presently promotes 12 monthly HBO Latino telecasts, called Oscar De La Hoya Presenta Boxeo De Oro, plus Solo Boxeo shows on the Telefutura network, and boxing shows on ESPN2.

Englebrecht has also been involved with minor league sports for the past 18 years, as a team owner and a member of the Board of Directors, of the

California League Class A Rancho Cucamonga Quakes baseball team; and as one of the original owners of the Anaheim Piranhas, the Arena Football League team that played its games at the Arrowhead Pond of Anaheim in 1996 and 1997. He also owns Sportscaster Camps of America, the leading sports broadcasting training school in America, now in its 20th year, with over 2,200 sportscaster alumni.

Prior to the formation of Roy Englebrecht Promotions in 1981, Roy spent seven years as Director of Promotions for the Los Angeles Lakers, Los Angeles Kings, and all Forum events. While at the Forum, Roy developed The Laker Girls dance team, and was also responsible for the 1980 Lakers Championship Parade through downtown Los Angeles. He currently teaches class in the Sports Management Masters Degree programs, at both the University of San Francisco and Long Beach State. He is presently serving a four-year term on the Newport Beach Parks, Beaches & Recreation Commission.

Roy has been married for 34 years to Nancy, a real estate agent with Coldwell Banker in Newport Beach. They have two children, Allison West, 28, a former college and pro volleyball player, and a teacher and Varsity Girls Volleyball Coach at Santa Ana High School, and Drew, 24, a sociology major at Vanguard University. Allison is married to former MISL & CISL soccer star Matty West, and they have one child, Gibson Shay West.

Englebrecht received a Bachelor of Science degree in Physical Education, from John Brown University, and a MEd graduate degree from Northeastern Oklahoma State University.
