If you have federal government business subject to the FAR, did you know your contracts may now include language addressing combating trafficking in persons? FAR clause 52.222-50 became effective in August 2007 via an interim rule (see FAC 2005-19 and 72 FR 46335). It's required in all FAR-based contracts and subcontracts!
